- Second Chance for YO Act (A6769/S282) will expand access to youthful offender (YO) status
 to people who were eligible for it, but were instead convicted in adult court, allowing them a
 second chance to have their records sealed.
- Ending the Arrest and Prosecution of Children Under 12 (S4051/A4982) will raise the age of juvenile delinquency from 7 to 12 years old in family court.


