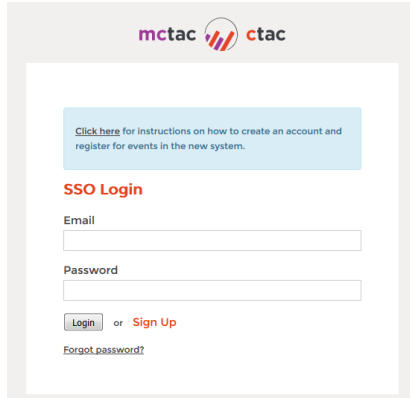


How to log in for Family Peer Advocate Training
