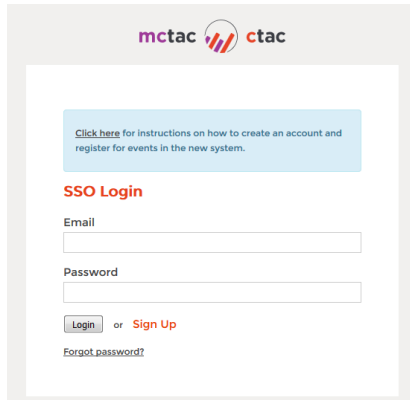


How to log in for Youth Peer Advocate Training
