NYS Systems of Care Pilot Sponsored Free Training Peer Participation in High Fidelity Wraparound

High Fidelity Wraparound is an intensive, team based planning process for youth and families that is often more successful with family and youth peer partnership. Care managers in your county are implementing Wraparound and you may be invited to be a member of a child and family team.

This series is intended for all Family Peer Advocates, Youth Peer Advocates, and Supervisors.

As a result of this self-paced and trainer-led series, participants will be able to:

- Describe how the philosophy of Peer Services and Wraparound are similar and complement each other (SOC).
- Explain how peer services can support a youth and family through activities in each of the four phases of wraparound.
- Recognize that Peer Services within CFTSS (Children and Family Treatment and Supports) are delivered the same when the Peer is a member of the Child & Family Team.
- Highlight the importance of collaboration amongst the Care Manager, Family Peer Advocate and Youth Peer Advocate.
