Virtual Zoom Event FANS Basic Training April 15, 16, 17 & 18, 2024



Participants must complete the following:

- Four concurrent 2.5-hour sessions with homework each session
- Must participate in-person for all four days of training to be able to take the test and certify.
- A passing grade on the on-line test of 70% or more is required for successful use of FANS with parents/caregivers

Criteria for taking training:

- FTNYS FPA Provisional or Professional Credential
- Currently work as an FPA, or have worked as an FPA within the last calendar year

The intent of this credentialing process is to formally recognize the expertise of Family Peer Advocates, to ensure all advocates demonstrate core competencies, to expand reimbursement possibilities, and to provide opportunities for professional growth and collaboration.
