



Safety and Security – best practices, conference attendees

- Communication is the most important element in any situation of safety concern. Please know that our first objective is the safety of our guests and associates.
- As a general rule, no matter where you are in the building we ask that you be observant of all exit doors in the event you are asked to evacuate the premises.
- Be alert of where the nearest staff member is, as they are best equipped to get help for any reason.
- There is a fire pull station near each exit. Should something happen that requires trained professionals and you are unable to locate a staff member the pull station is addressable thereby alerting us of the area where help is needed.
- If you find yourself or a roommate in distress in your room, dial 911. The 911 dispatcher will notify us and the appropriate services for your emergency.
- You can notify hotel personnel of an issue by dialing "O" from any house phone located in each meeting room and outside of the main corridor leading to the ballroom.
- All of the hotel managers are trained in CPR and First Aid. Some of the team is trained in active shooter and anti –terrorism awareness.
