42% Nearly half of all young people who experience homelessness do so more than once.

50% About half of all unhoused youth were homeless for the first time this past year.

4.2 million young people in the United States experience a form of homelessness









Youth Homelessness

Black youth face an 83% higher risk of homelessness compared to their white peers.





LGBTQ+ youth
are more than
TWICE as likely to
have experienced
homelessness.





Young parents, especially unmarried, have a 3 times higher risk than their nonparenting peers

That's approximately 700,000 youth
