## WHAT IS THE FPA CREDENTIAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE ?

Started in 2016, The Family Peer Advocate Credential Advisory Committee (FPACAC) is made up of experienced Family Peer Advocates from across the state to ensure a broad, multi-system voice in the process of training and credentialing.

This is an exciting time in the development of the Family Peer Advocate profession and our work will be crucial to ensure that, as we grow, we continue to be guided by the principles of Family Peer Support.

## WHAT IS THE ROLE & RESPONSIBILITY OF MEMBERS?



- Meet virtually 10 times per year via Zoom for a 1-hour call.
- Represent the FPA voice in the professional training and credentialing programs.
- Advise the FTNYS Training & Workforce Development Department on policies and procedures related to the Parent Empowerment Program Training and the Family Peer Advocate Credential.
- Review and make written determinations on applications when there is a question about eligibility.
- Review, investigate and make determinations on Code of Ethics violations.
